

## February Parish News

This month's meeting was held in the Parish hall on Monday the 18<sup>th</sup> of February.

The provision of a new footbridge at Langbridge which will provide a safe pedestrian route over the river has moved up a pace with the County Council agreeing to process all planning requirements at their expense and Island roads supporting the provision of the paths leading up to the bridge, we now feel we can place an order for the actual bridge which will be built and fitted by a local company.

A "Just Giving " account has been created where people can donate whatever they can to help raise the £ 20000 we need to top up the Parish councils fund. This money will be solely used for this project . We will be approaching local companies as well as local and national organisations that may be able to support this cause with grants.
